Ways to use in the classroom:

- Record a book review (opinion)
- Tell a summary of a book
- Create a radio show or news report
- A mock interview with the characters
- Retell the plot in a different characters perspective
- Debating, or arguing a certain point

Digital Story



Digital Story Description:

Incorporates visual (video) and audio together to create a digital story.

Tools we used:

- WeVideo (free online, 15 minutes of publishing time, 5 GB)
- iMovie (installed in apple products: computers, iPads)



Ways to use in the classroom:

- Public service announcements
- Create commercials
- Video's focusing on character development
- Create summaries of the book in the form of a book trailer
- Informational videos that focus on important issues mentioned in the text
- Creating an alternative ending to a book, or reenacting an important part of the text
- Connecting the text to yourself

Infographic Description:

A visual image such as a chart, graph, or poster, or diagram to represent information or data.

Tools we used:

- Piktochart (online resource that includes free templates)

Ways to use in the classroom:

- Informational projects
- Substitute for posters
- Public service announcements
- Research projects
- Any way to display information!
