Shift Audience -----> Who else could you cast as the audience for this lesson?

Shift Authenticity -----> How might you re-imagine the authenticity (connection to real world relevance) for this lesson?

Shift Content ----> How might this content change or be understood differently in a digital space?

Shift Focus ----> What cross-curricular connections could you imagine creating for this content?



Shift Roles -----> How could the direction of this lesson be translated (ie from

teacher-directed to student-directed?

Shift Control ----> How could decision-making and choice be positioned

differently in this lesson?

Shift Engagement -----> How could the learning activities provide greater

engagement and active learning for students?

Shift Assessment -----> In what other ways might students demonstrate their

understandings of learning goals?
